Ephesians 4:1 – Today we are going to talk about on how to live worthy of our calling. Calling is something we talk about in church, but rarely see lived in life. We discuss in Bible Study but don't walk in it on the job. You Are Called - This letter was written by the Apostle Paul while in prison in Rome. Most people would go on & on about their situation, but Paul only alludes to being a "prisoner" then reframes the thought to reflect a different view as a prisoner of the Lord

- I. People can be bound and imprisoned by so many things in life. Money, fame, drugs, people's opinions, failure, depression, THEMSELVES (self-centeredness). When you make yourself a prisoner of the LORD... you are set free and nothing in this world has to bind you ever again.
 - A. Paul begged them to WALK/LIVE their life for something that truly matters. AMP "I appeal to and beg you to walk (lead a life) worthy of the [divine] calling to which you have been called."
 - I don't care who you are, how old you are, or what your skills are. GOD has DESTINY for you to do. You are a part of His plan at work here through FCFTucson. You are a part of His plan at work in our community and in your vocation.
 - B. Don't lose sight of the value and reality that GOD has something amazing for you to do. Calling "God's personal invitation for me to work on His agenda, using the talents I've been given in ways that are eternally significant." life@work magazine
- II. Eph 3:14-21 Living worthy of your calling/vocation sounds really difficult, but while praying for the church Paul reveals 8 ideas & truths to help you walk worthy of the calling to which you are called.
 - A. #1 Maintain a Divine Perspective It is time we stopped living life from earth to heaven, and instead SIMPLY live from heaven to earth. Eph 3:15, Eph 2:6, Jn14:12, Joshua 6
 - B. #2 You are stronger than you think "...be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man." Eph 3:16, Eph 6:10
 - 1. What have you been trying to do in your own strength? Quit it. You are not strong enough alone, but in Christ you can whoop any Giant. (David & Goliath.)
 - C. #3 You are not alone "Christ dwells in your heart through faith." Eph 3:17, Heb 13:5 He said He'd never leave you & He meant it.
 - D. #4 Love is your foundation "rooted... in Love" Eph3:17
 - 1. Where you shop, live & work is the mission field. LOVE is what helps you see it that way. If we don't see it that way... then we

- need to go back to the Gospel and take another dip in His grace and LOVE. Love is WHY we live.
- E. #5 Love will keep you grounded "...grounded in love" Love is HOW we live. It keeps us humble, because love always puts others 1st. Eph 3:17-18
 - 1. Breadth It is embracing & available to ALL. Length It is eternal. From everlasting to everlasting. Depth It can't be understood in words. Height No enemy can touch it.
- F. #6 **He LOVES you** We will never be able to put into natural terms the love of God, but PRAISE HIM you can KNOW & Experience it. Eph 3:19
- G. #7 There is more in you than you can possibly imagine Eph3:19 Jn1:16 Filled Plē-roō Gk Means to cram full.
 - 1. He is constantly filling you with more of who HE is
 - Never underestimate what He has put in you If/when you do...
 you overlook YOUR capacity. He is asking you to BUST out of
 the way you see yourself, break through the world's limitations
 and realize His Fullness in you.
- H. #8 God's dream is exceedingly abundantly bigger. Eph 3:20 People can think of a lot of crazy stuff (look online), but God is beyond THAT. He has a dream for you that is bigger than yours.
 - 1. It is bigger than who you are, It's bigger than what you can dream. That means He is thinking about you!
- III. He's put so much in YOU! Therefore walk worthy of that calling and vocation to which you have been called. PAUL begged the church in Ephesus to lead a life worthy of your calling, for you have been called by God, because he knew that when we come together and each of us LIVES worthy of the vocation to which we've been called, influencing those around us in every arena that it causes tremendous growth in the BODY!
