## Principles for a Transformed Life (PTL) Principle #7: Service to Others

We have sown much bad seed. We need to begin planting a new crop. Our life of service includes helping people in trouble and carrying the message of freedom in Jesus Christ.

- We are created to serve one another. It feels good to have purpose in life.

What verses of Scripture helped you when you were first starting out in your Christian life?


Describe your own experience in salvation and getting free from drugs and alcohol.
